

With it, we feel like we can change the world.

Without it, life seems to lose steam.

So we went on a mission to find and learn from one of the most passionate people we know...Charlotte Gambill! (Who just so happens to be a guest speaker at Original this year!) During this candid interview with Conference Host, Jen DeWeerdt, and her dear friend, we'll learn how passion is a choice...definitely worth choosing!

Jen: I would definitely describe you as a passionate person. What does living passionately look like for you? Why is it important?

Charlotte: I think your passion is your permission. In life it's the passion we have that motivates us to go further and aim higher. Passion is like fuel to our soul, the enemy loves to dilute our passion and move us from hot to lukewarm. He wants to replace passion with apathy, and in doing so he is able to neutralize so many people's destinies. I think where passion begins to weaken we also find commitment lessens, and with less commitment comes less achieving; and so I believe we have to stay passionately in love with Jesus. What you are passionate about is driving you, so it is important we get our passions positioned well.

Jen: So, do you always *feel* passionate?

Charlotte: No. Same way I don't always feel excited or energized or even capable, passion is something we have to commit to keep fired up. When Paul spoke to his eager student Timothy, he told him to 'fan into flame the gift in you'; in other words where are you adding some consistent commitment? However gifted you are the flame can go out. I refuel my passion regularly by remembering the why behind the what; why I do what I do, why I serve, why I give. I constantly commit to fan into flame my passion, my worship, and my time in the Word and prayer. By adding adventure and joy, and reminding myself of my purpose—my schedule, ministry, parenting, marriage, and relationship with Jesus all receive a passion infusion on a regular basis.

Jen: Tell us about your daily rhythms and practices. What big and little things do you do to keep your passion for God and for people strong and your mission clearly before you?

Charlotte: Jesus said when he was heading to the cross "for the joy set before me"... in other words what He saw was fuel for what He was about to do. You stay full of passion by what you choose to see. You can see an overcrowded schedule, or choose to see the privilege you have been entrusted with and the things you have been called to do. You can see piles of laundry and frustrating children, or choose to see your family as a gift from God you have been blessed with and responsible to care for. How we view what we do either drains our passion or refuels it. Also for me it's hard to maintain a passionate life if I have an unhealthy lifestyle. We need to stay well to do well and passion requires our whole being to be active and healthy, so I also watch my diet, manage my late nights, and exercise daily. It doesn't sound fun but the results make it all worthwhile.

Jen: What would you say to someone who looks at you and says, "Sure, she is making a difference...but what about me? What can I possibly do?"

Charlotte: You can do what I can't do. I don't live on your street, your neighbors are not my responsibility, they are yours. Your children and husband need you not me. Your work place is your area to influence and bless. The question is so often not "what can I do" but "what am I willing to do?" We all have to wake up to the fact that we are accountable for the seed we have been entrusted with. I can't sow your seed for you and I am not answerable for that seed, only my own. Just like the parable of the talents, the one who had more was not the reason or excuse for the one who had been given less to do. God knows it's all our part that makes the whole picture work; don't allow faulty thinking to rob you of your own harvest.

Jen: If you could sit down with each of our readers, what would you say to them in regards to living a life full of passion?

Charlotte: I would grab each sweet girl by the hand and whisper in her ear "come on my friend, we need you, its time to wake up and get to it." I would ask her "what are you waiting for?" And say, "just start somewhere." I would turn her face heavenward to her Father and remind her this is not just about her, and her insecurity can't have the final say. She is her Father's daughter, and when she remembers all He has done for her, she will respond with overwhelming gratitude. It's hard not to get passionate when you realize afresh that without His passion, you would have never found freedom.
